### **AUTO THEFT:**

On 09/17/2016 Officers responded to 5120 Butler Street located in Lawrenceville (10<sup>th</sup> Ward) for a VEHICLE THEFT Report. Upon arrival Officers spoke to the owner of the vehicle who stated she parked her vehicle in her normal spot at 1:00am and when she returned the vehicle was gone. Officers did not observe any signs of forced entry and there was no record of the vehicle being towed. There is no suspects at the current time; investigation to continue.

### **DRUG INCIDENTS:**

On 09/29/2016 Officers responded to the 100 block of McCandless Street located in Lawrenceville (10<sup>th</sup> Ward) for a possible drug overdose. En route Officers were notified the female victim was pronounced DOA by Medics. Upon arrival Officers spoke to the victim's boyfriend who stated he arrived home from work at 3:00pm and discovered the victim lying on the floor unresponsive. He immediately called 911, and when the medics arrived the female was in cardiac arrest and not breathing. Officers discovered empty stamp bags of heroin lying near the victim.

On 09/29/2016 Officers responded to the 5300 block of Camelia Street for a report of (2) people found DOA in their apartment. Upon arrival Officers spoke to the reporting person who stated she is neighbors with the victims and when she did not see them in a few days she became concerned. She looked in their window and observed a male slumped over lying near the bed. The neighbor stated she opened the window to render aid and discovered the female victim lying nearby unresponsive. The neighbor stated both victims were cold and hard and rigor mortis was beginning to set in. Medics arrived shortly afterward and pronounced both victims DOA. Further investigation Officers discovered (7) empty stamped bags of heroin lying on the kitchen table.
