DESCRIPTION:

Julian's Pub, LLC is seeking person-to-person and place-to-place transfer of liquor license No. R-12215 at 5238 Butler Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, 15201. Upon information and belief, Julian's Pub, LLC's sole member, Mr. James Haney, Jr. is not of good repute within the meaning of 47 P.S. § 4-404. Mr. Haney has been charged with, convicted of, and/or pled guilty to a number of crimes, including: simple assault, criminal conspiracy, possession with intent to distribute, recklessly endangering another person, criminal mischief, and disorderly conduct. Mr. Haney previously applied for a transfer of a liquor license for the same property, and his application was denied by both the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board and by the Allegheny County Court of Common Pleas because Mr. Haney was found to be not of good repute.

HOW LAWRENCEVILLE UNITED WILL BE AGGRIEVED:

Lawrenceville United and its 900 members have a direct interest in the proposed person-to-person and place-to-place liquor license transfer and, for the reasons set forth herein, will be aggrieved by a Board decision granting the proposed transfer. *See* 40 Pa. Code § 17.12; *Malt Beverages Distribution Ass'n v. Pa. Liquor Control Bd.*, 881 A.2d 37, 41 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2005) ("An association need only allege that one member is suffering immediate or threatened injury, in order to invoke standing as a representative of its members.")
