



# **HISTORY**

- 2012-2013, Upper Lawrenceville Community Visioning Plan –
  Lawrenceville United and Lawrenceville Corporation
  - Found greenspaces in Upper Lawrenceville were 'underutilized'
  - Identified Duncan as a possible site for urban food production and community green space
- 2014 Duncan Park was decommissioned
- Vision for Duncan Park as a neighborhood gathering place where kids can play and learn, and where we can see some of the natural assets of Western PA.
- Volunteer-led project workgroup and dedication of residents






















Duncan Orchard Proposed Plan (Revised) (1) Scale: 1" = 20'-0"





#### the project

We've heard from residents, loud and clear, that creating play opportunities at Duncan Park is a neighborhood priority. We want to make that happen, and we want to build it together. Lawrenceville United (LU) has been engaged in a multi-year effort to revitalize Duncan Park, a City of Pittsburgh park decommissioned in May of 2014, and transform it into a community orchard, garden, and play space. The next big step in this project is to install a 12 foot long embankment slide into the hillside at Duncan Park. The slide will be the centerpiece of the proposed new play equipment.
