

Lawrenceville Veterans Banner Project Fact Sheet

What is the Project: The VFW Post 214 Veterans Banner Project is a project to honor our neighbors for their service to our country. Interested individuals have an opportunity to purchase a banner for a family member or loved one that will be put up along Butler Street or adjoining streets in May 2019.

Who can get a banner: Banners may be purchased by any person to recognize a living or deceased US Armed Services veteran.

How does it work? Fill out our form with all necessary information about the service member you are memorializing. Attach a headshot and check. The committee will order your banner and hang it in May, 2019. The committee is coordinating the ordering and hanging of the banners.

How long will the banner be on display? From late May through early July, pending Art Commission approval.

Who will hang the banner and take it down? The committee is working with agencies to have all banners hung and removed and working to raise funds for the cost of labor and installation and removal.

Can I have my banner once it is removed? Banners are stored at the VFW. If you want to keep yours please ask!

Who is in charge of this project? VFW Post 214

If I don't buy one this year, will there be another opportunity in the future? Yes! This is an annual project.

What does my fee cover? For Phase 2 (current phase of this project), the fee of \$150 covers banner design, production, hardware to hang banner, installation, removal, and storage. If you ordered a banner in Phase 1 (in 2018), the cost is \$100.

Can I see a picture of the banners? Examples of banners will be available at meetings about the Veterans Banners project.
