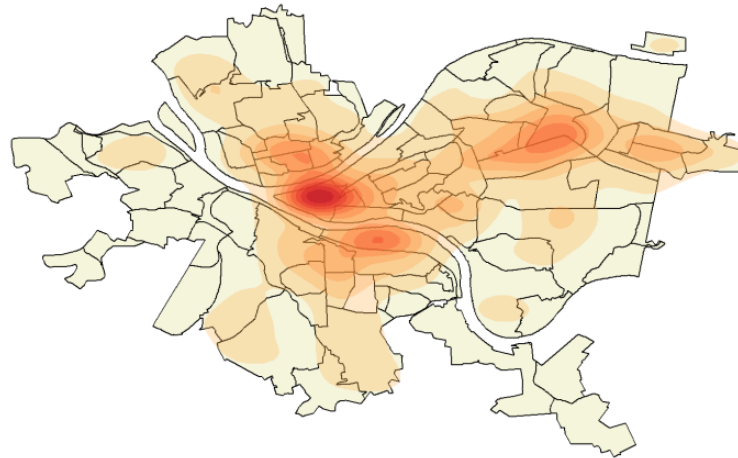
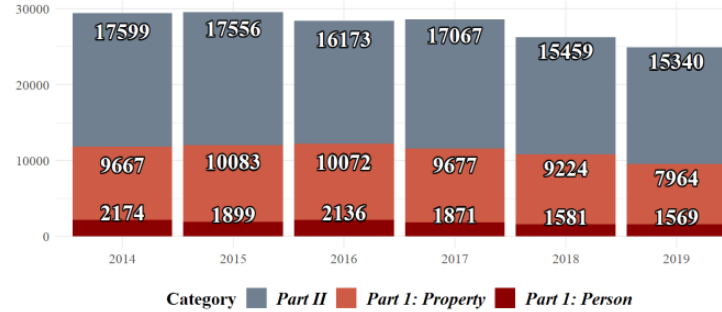

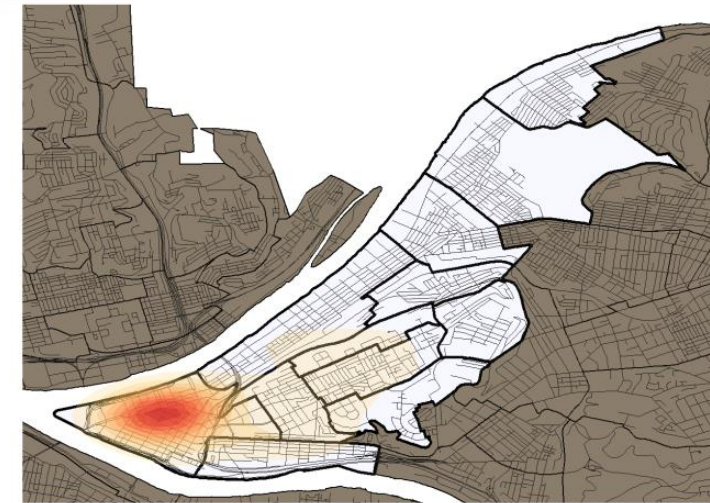

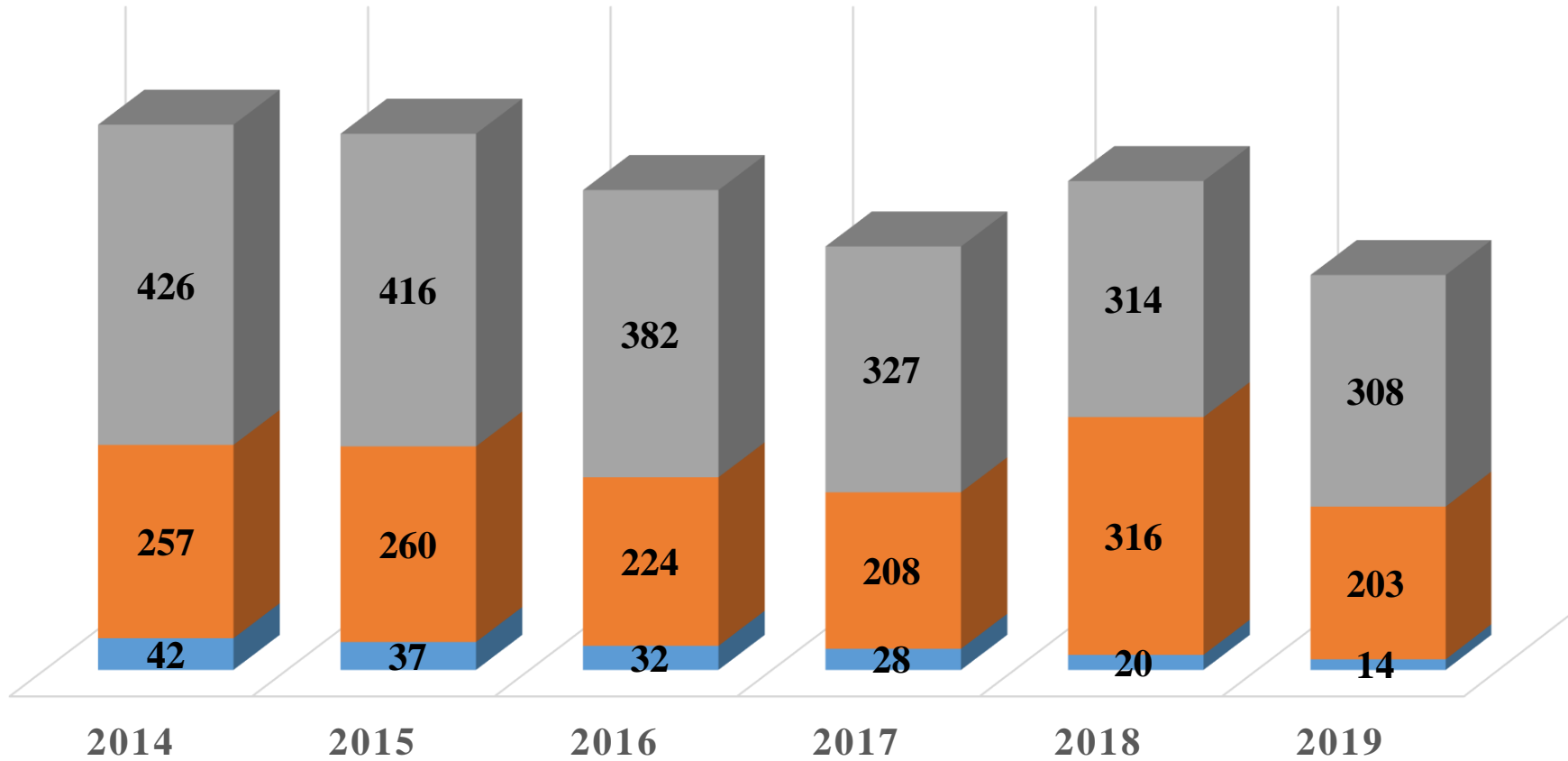

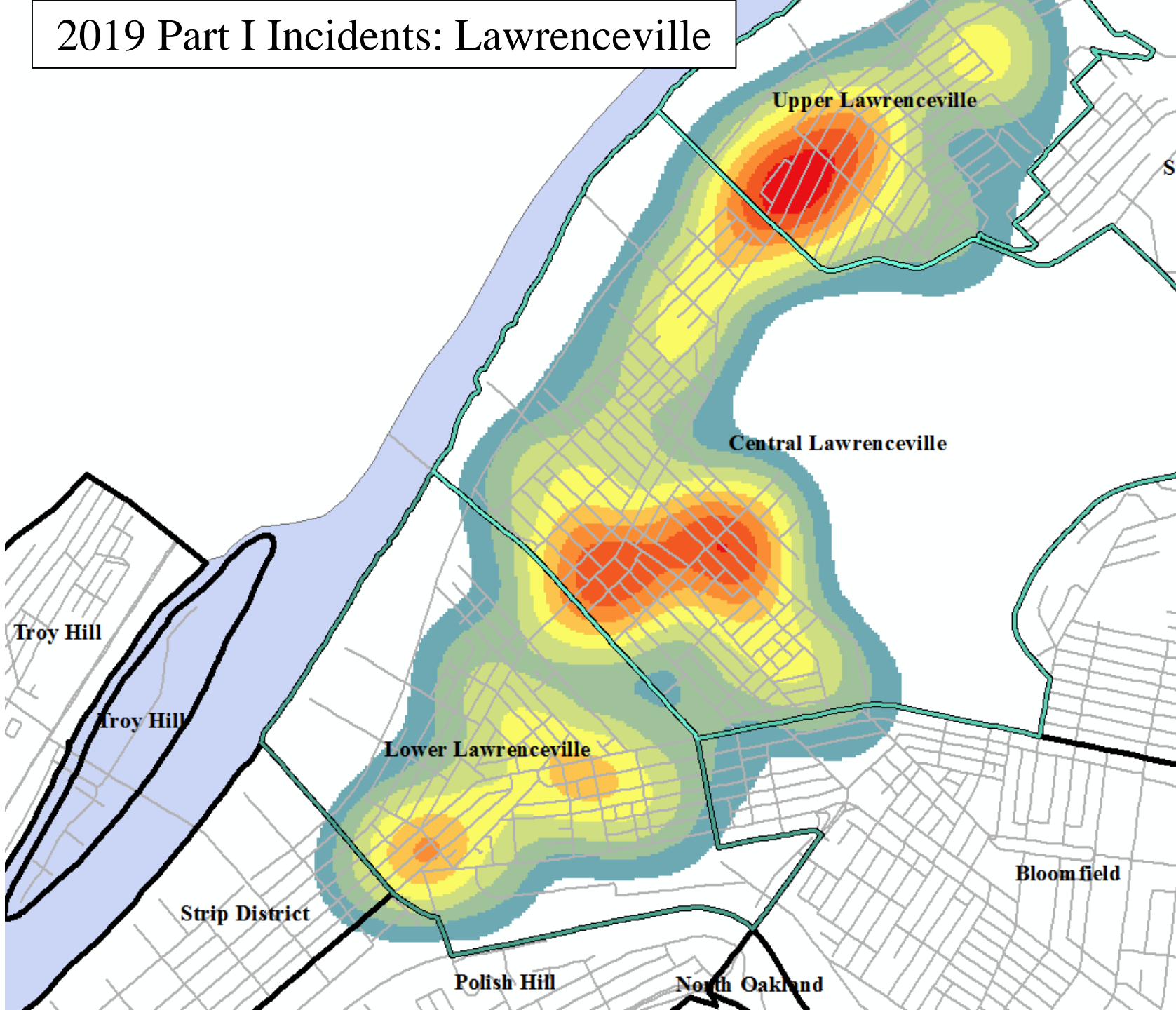

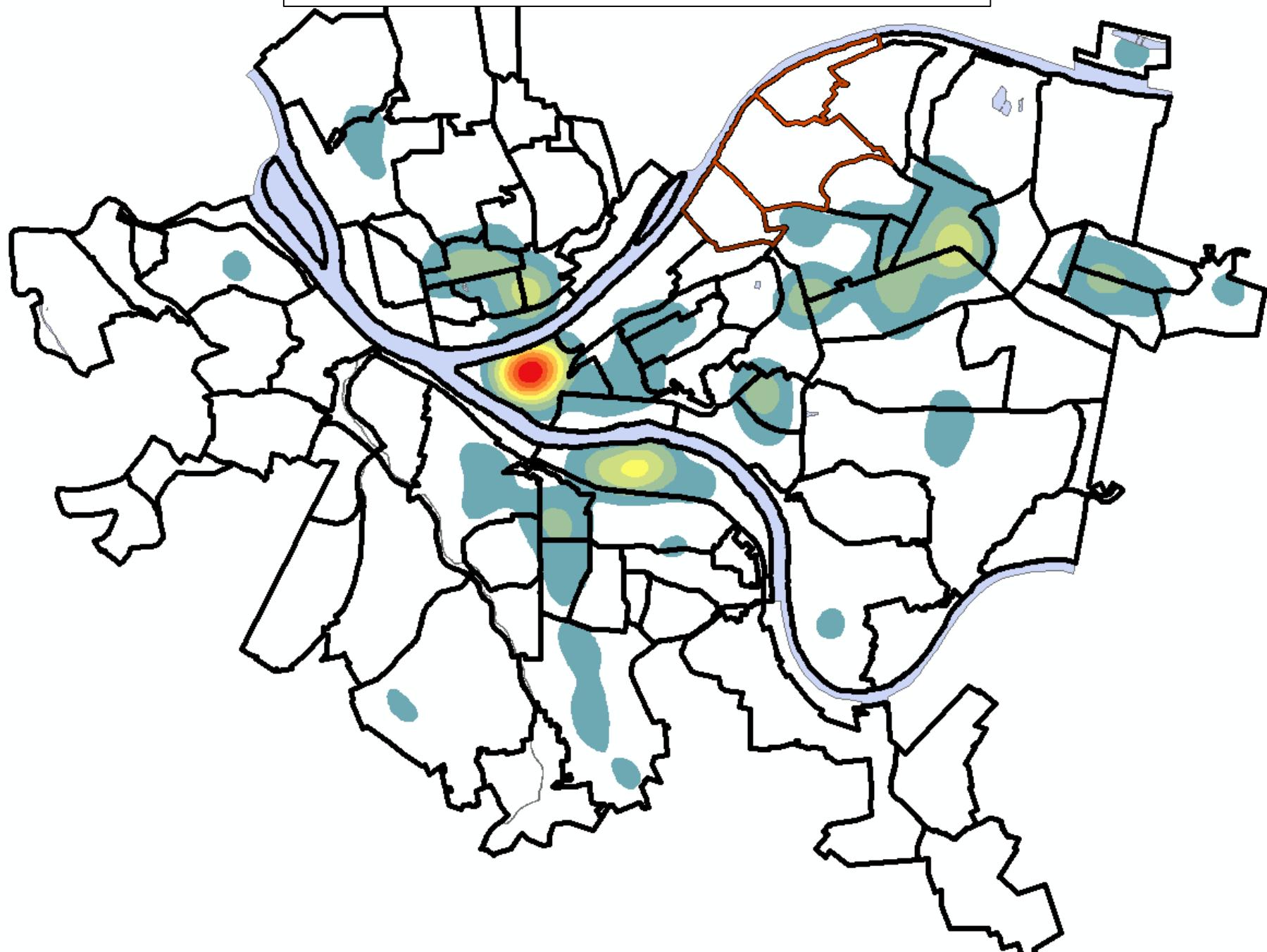

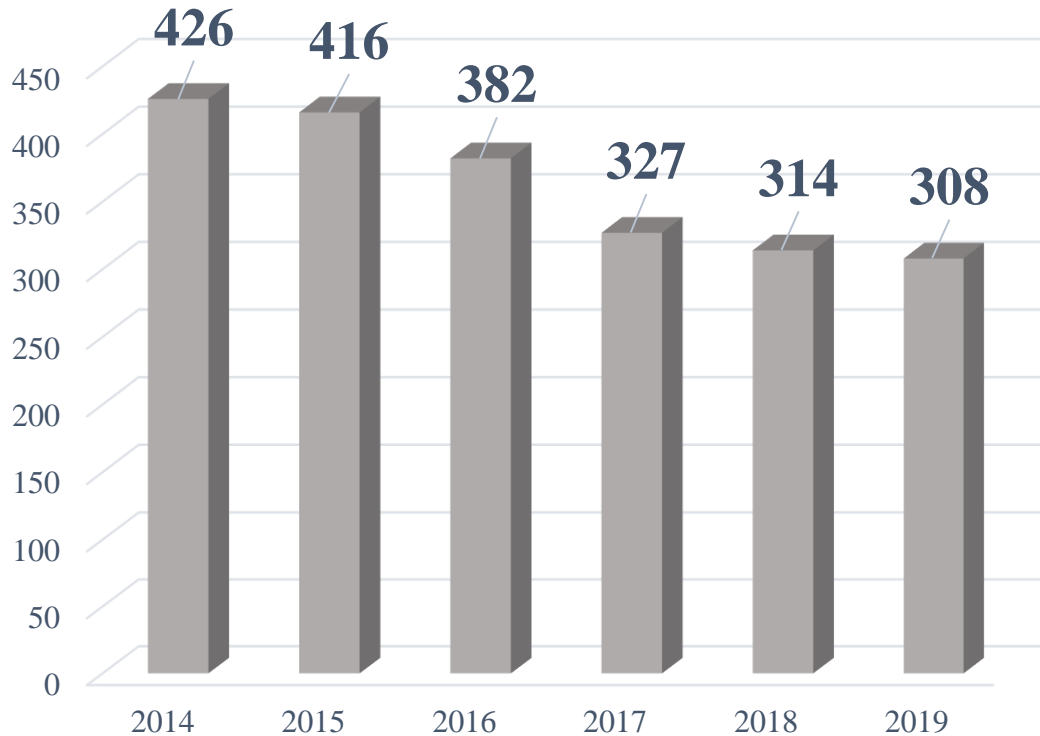

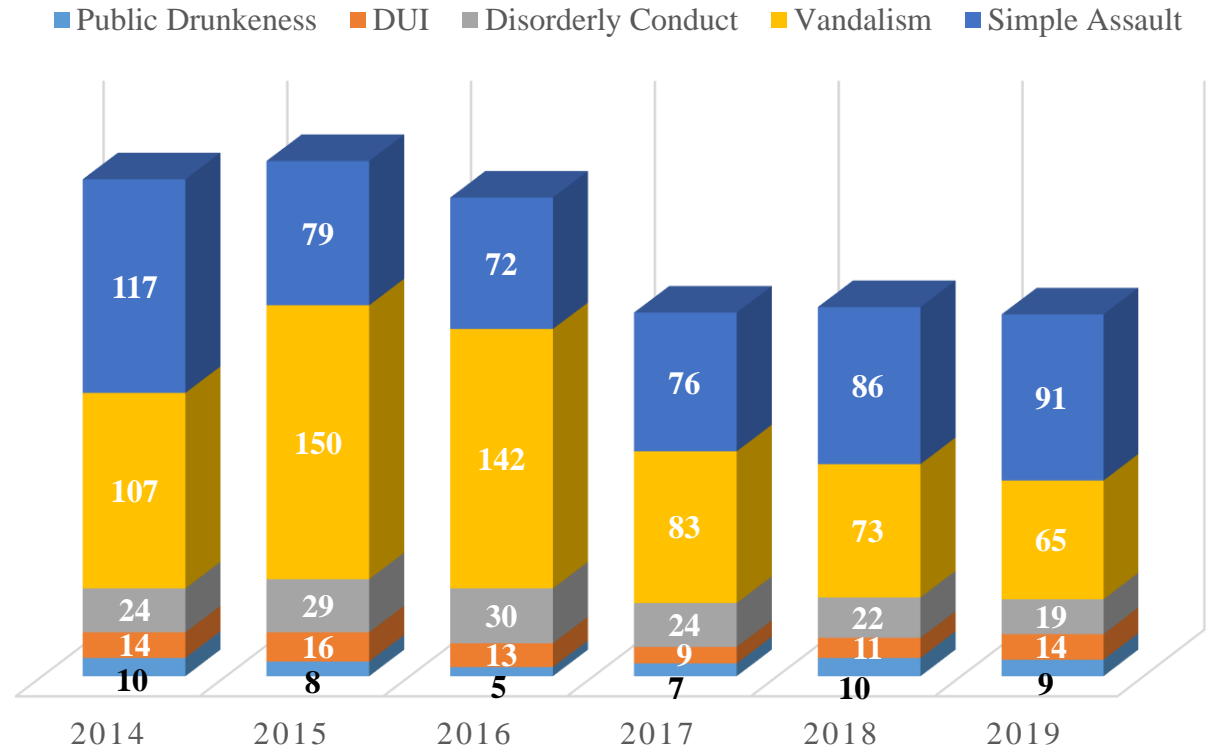

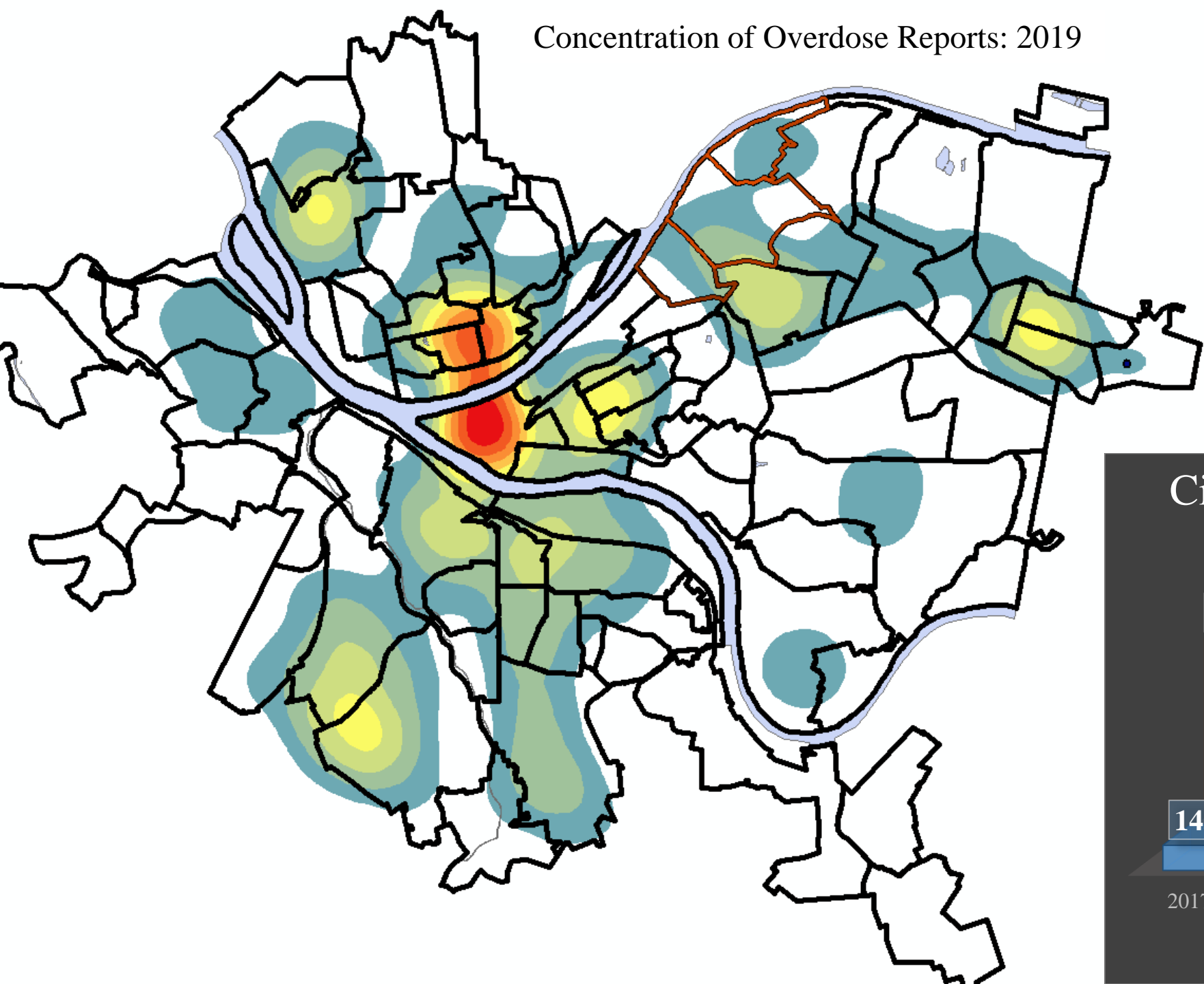
### Total Part II Crime Incidents: Lawrenceville



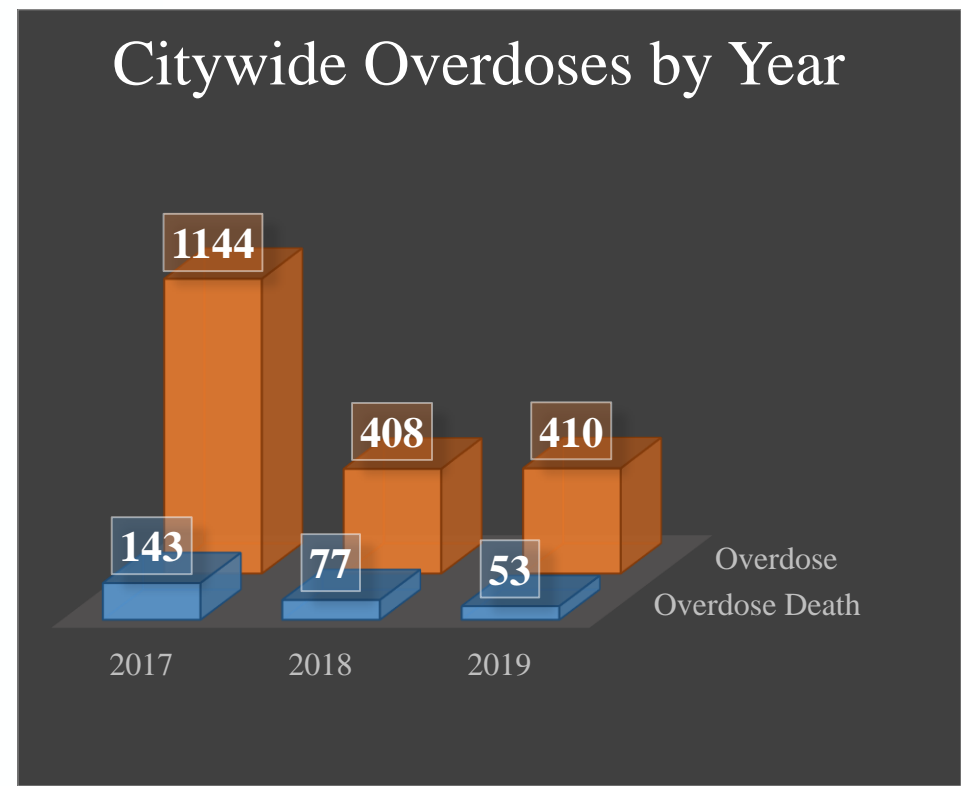

# Concentration of Overdose Reports: 2019



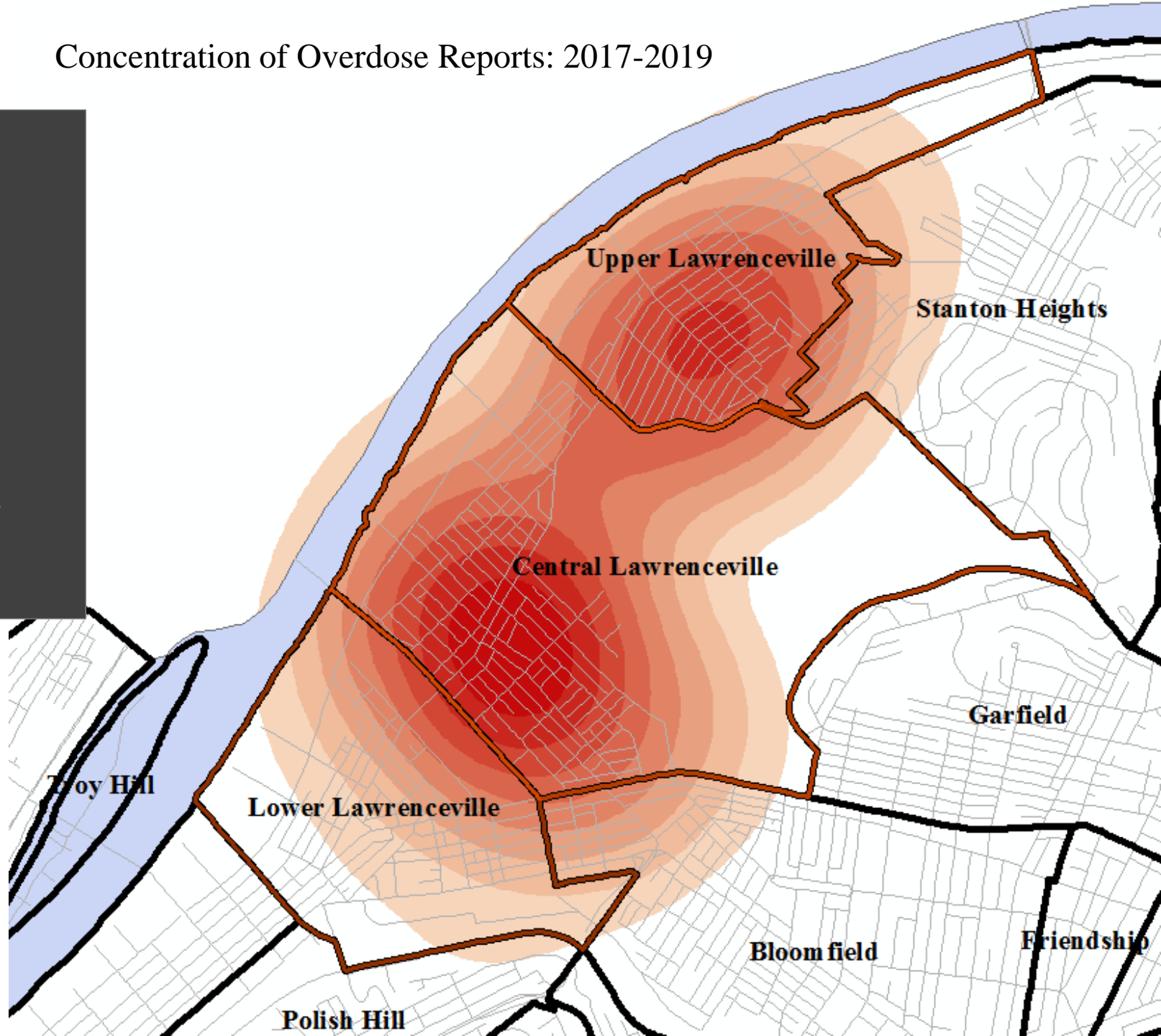
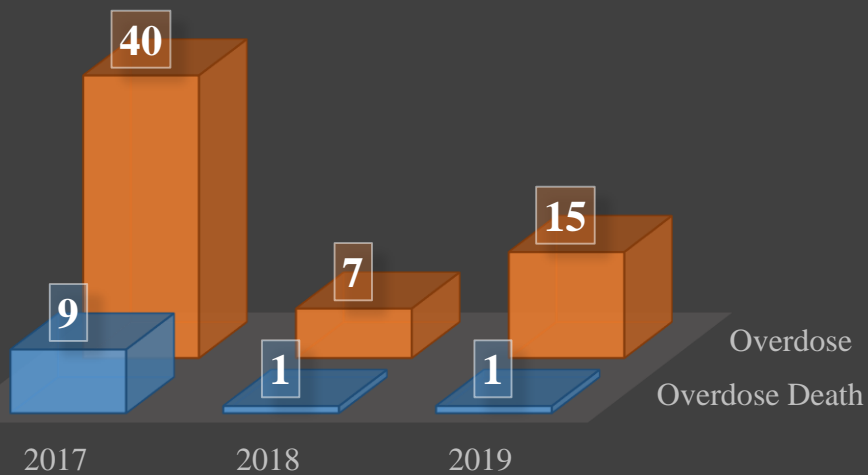
## Citywide Overdoses by Year

### Takeaways...

- Citywide crime in 2019 was down;
- A trend even more pronounced in Lawrenceville;
- Most sizeable decrease has been in Violent Crimes, down 56% over 5yr average;
- Concentrations remain along Butler St. corridor (51<sup>st</sup> – 55<sup>st</sup> Streets & 40<sup>th</sup> – 45<sup>th</sup> Streets)
- Heroin Overdoses dropped significantly between 2017 & 2018 with modest increases in 2019;
- Small increases in some ‘Nuisance’ crimes, and large decreases in others;
