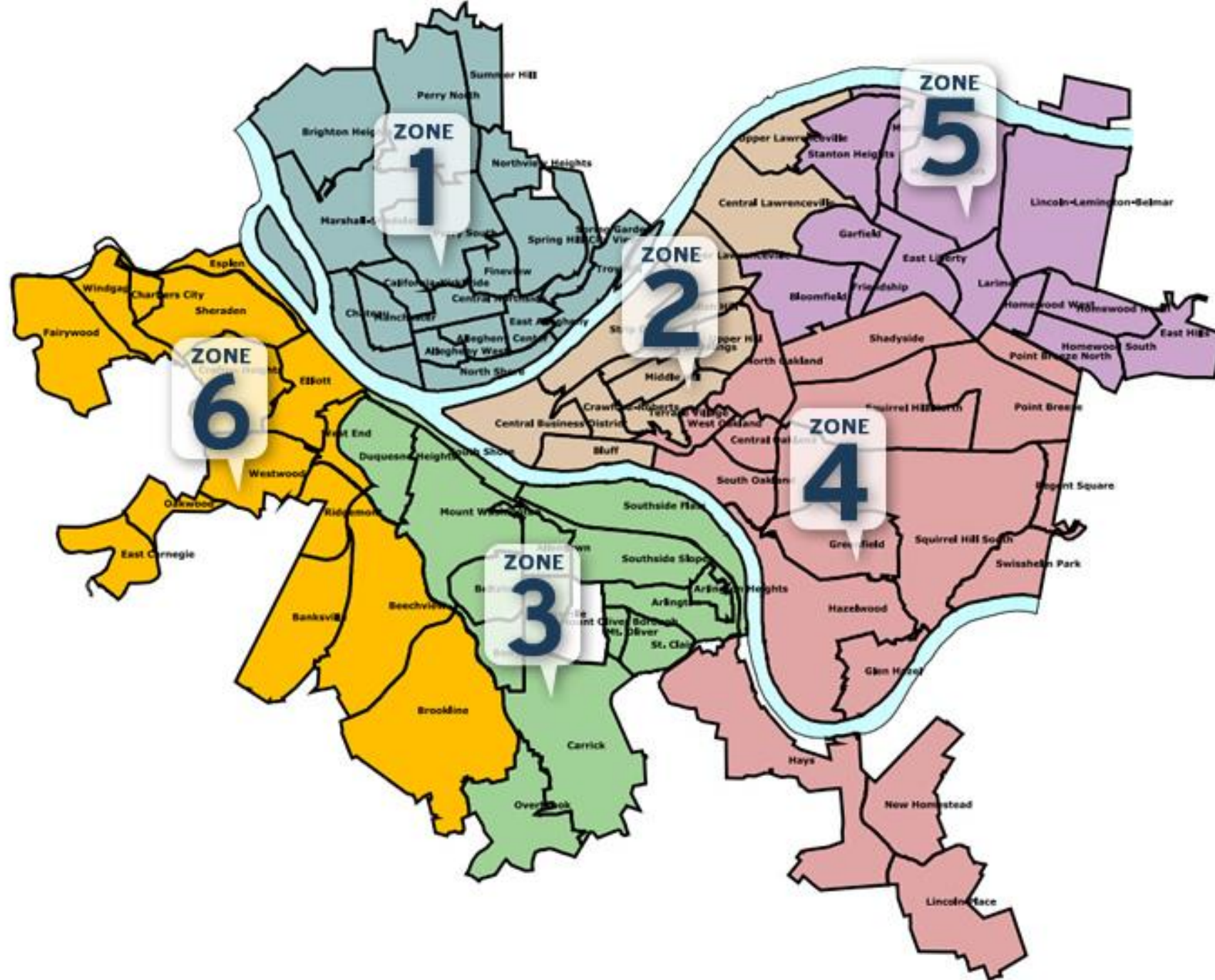

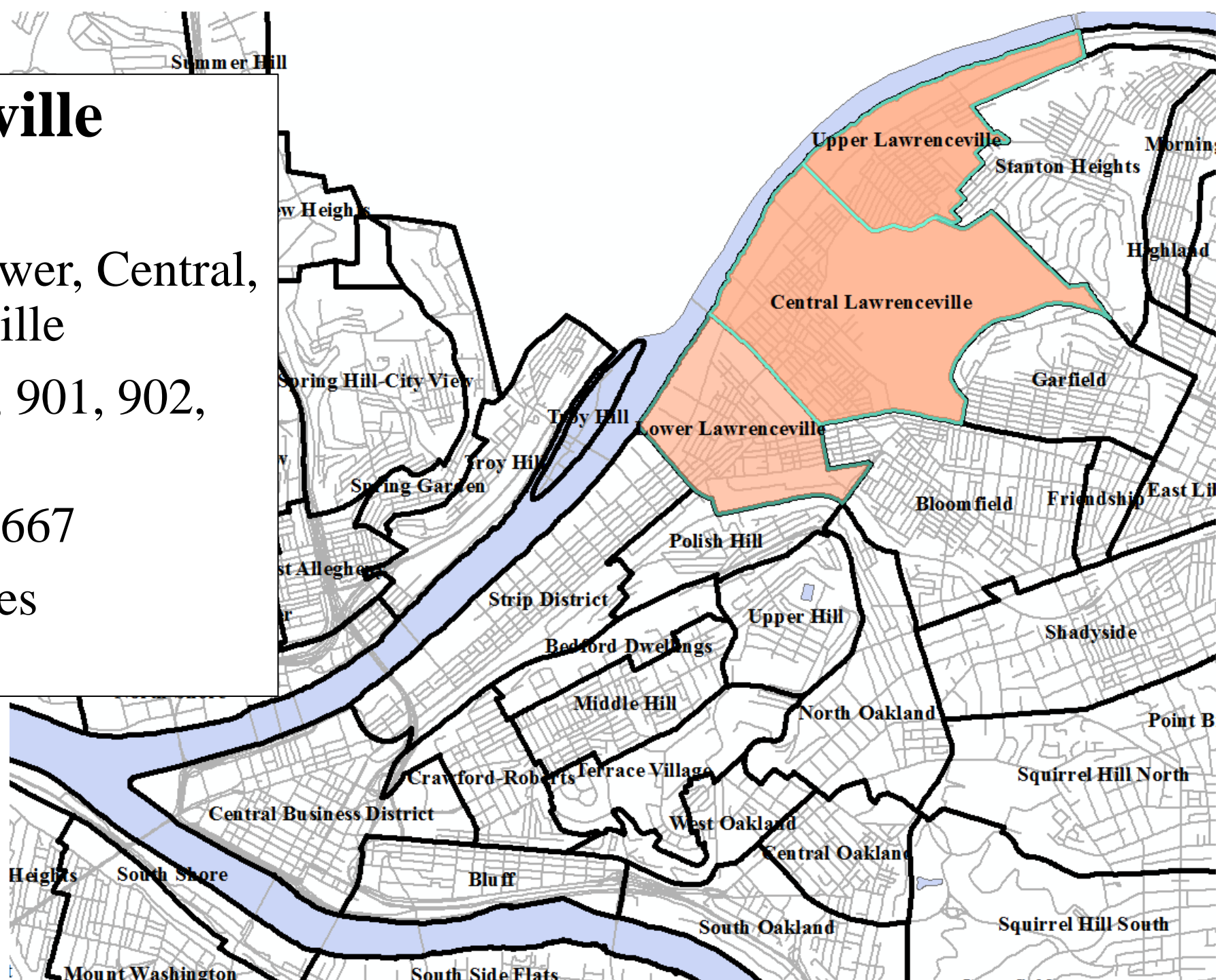

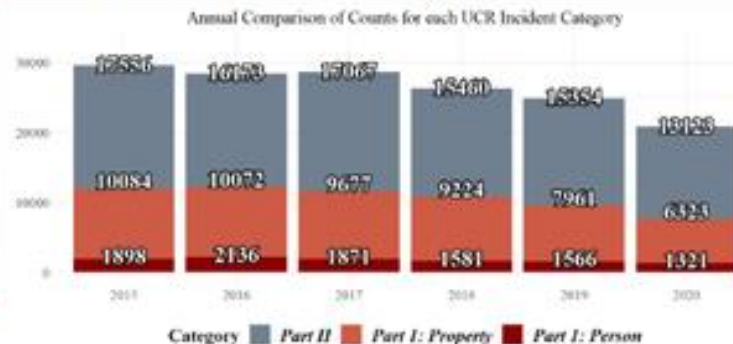
Incidents Reported in City of Pittsburgh from January to December 2020

City-Wide UCR Crimes 2020

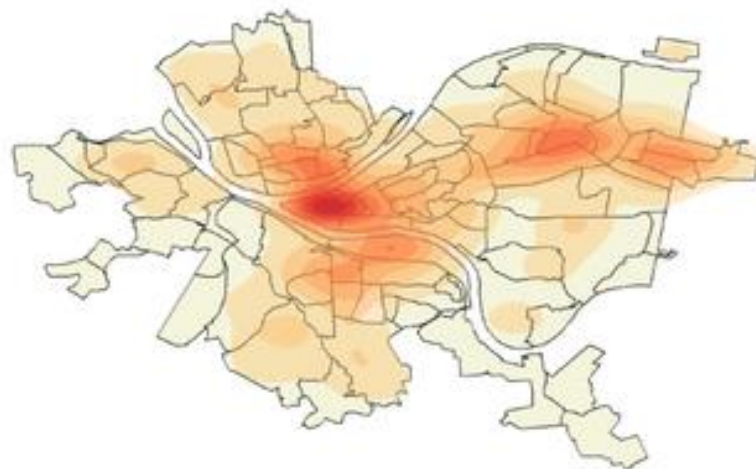

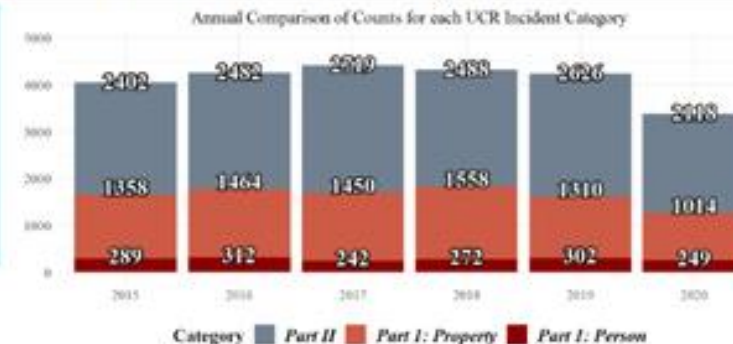

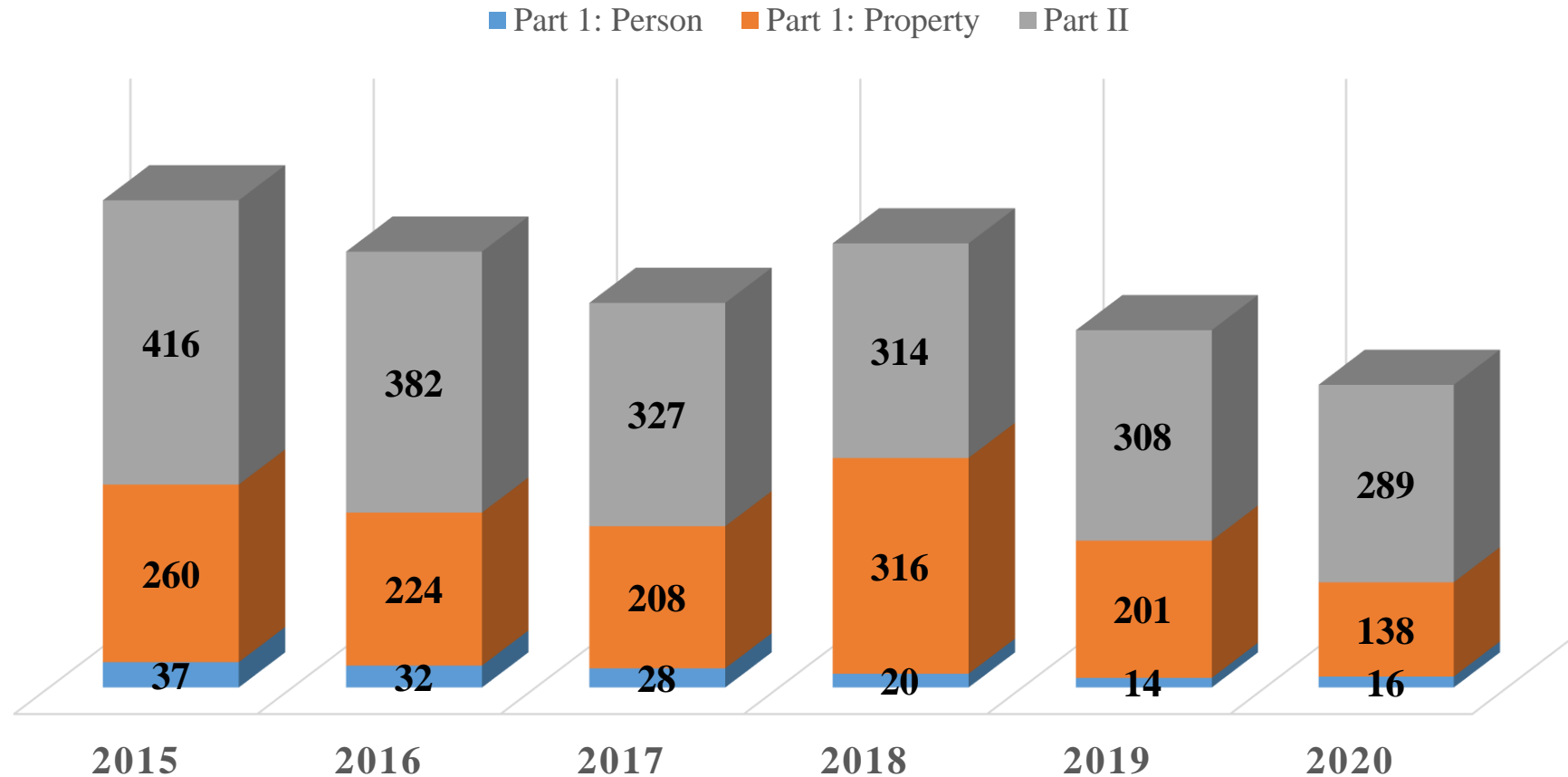

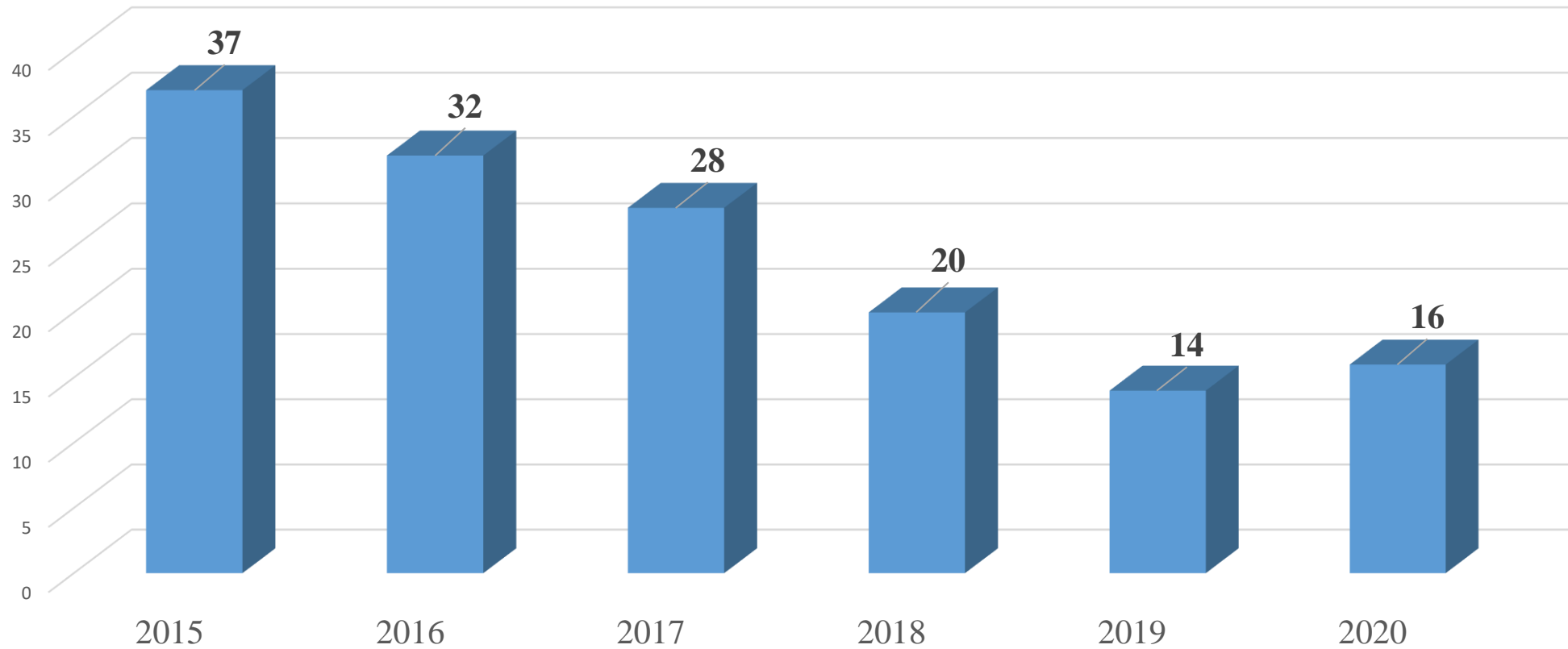

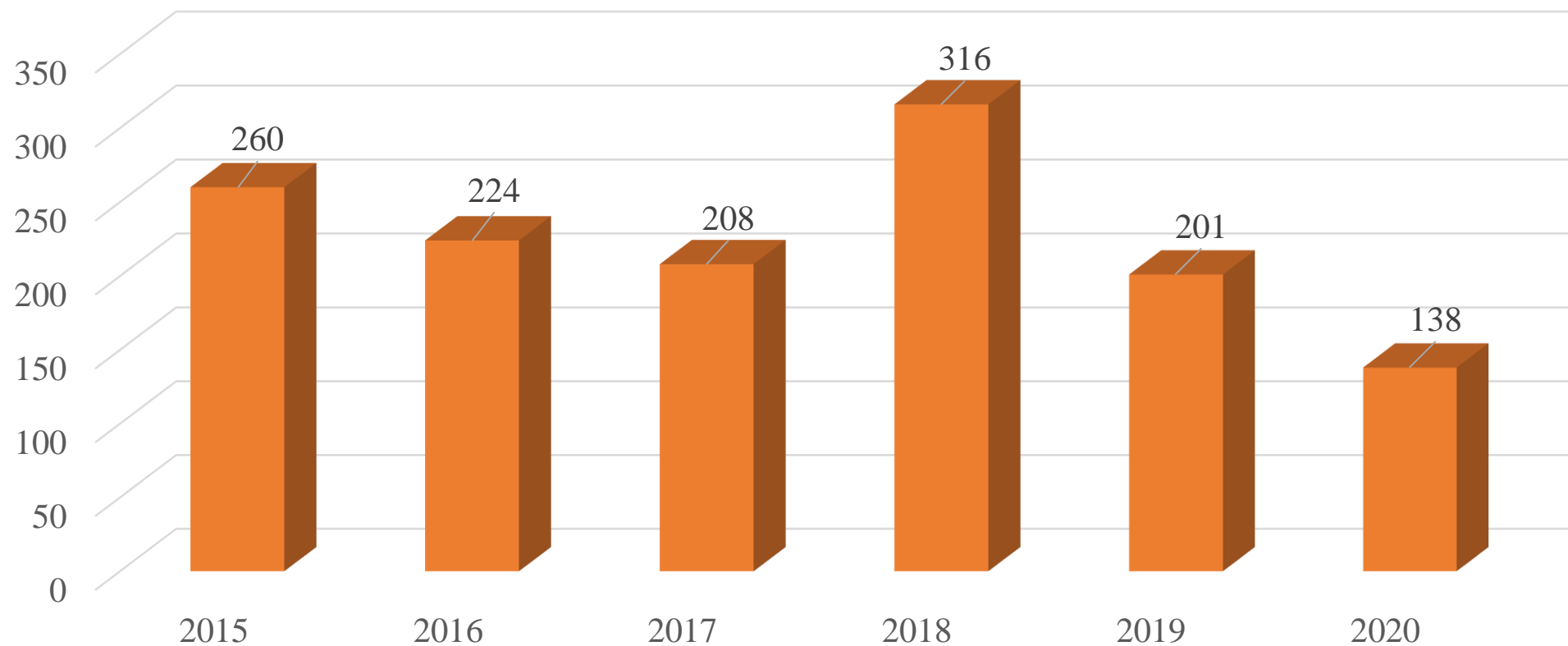

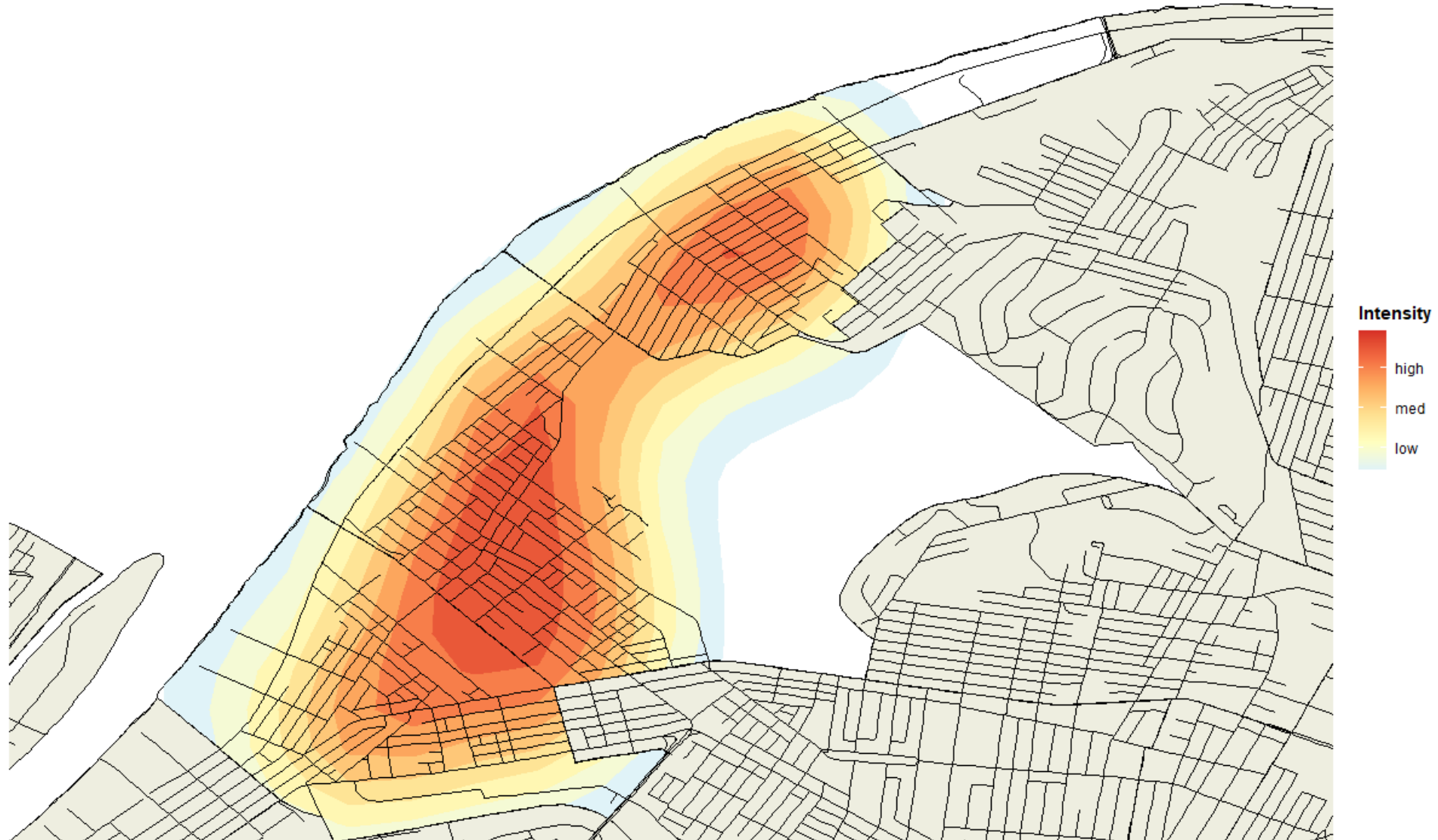


Lawrenceville Part 1 Property Crimes by Year

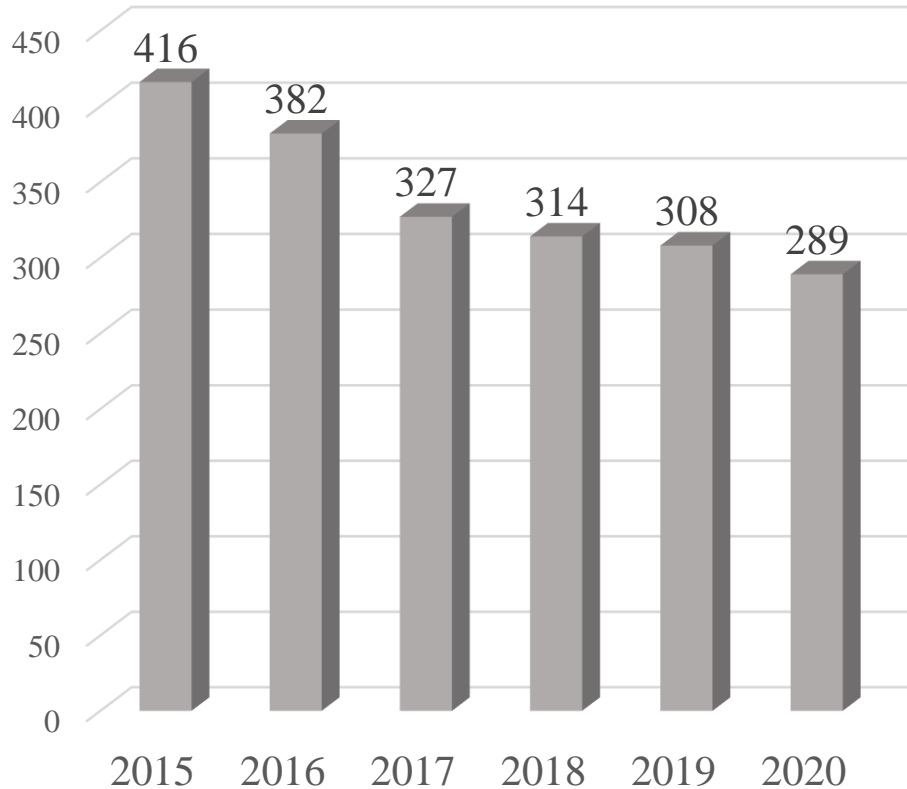

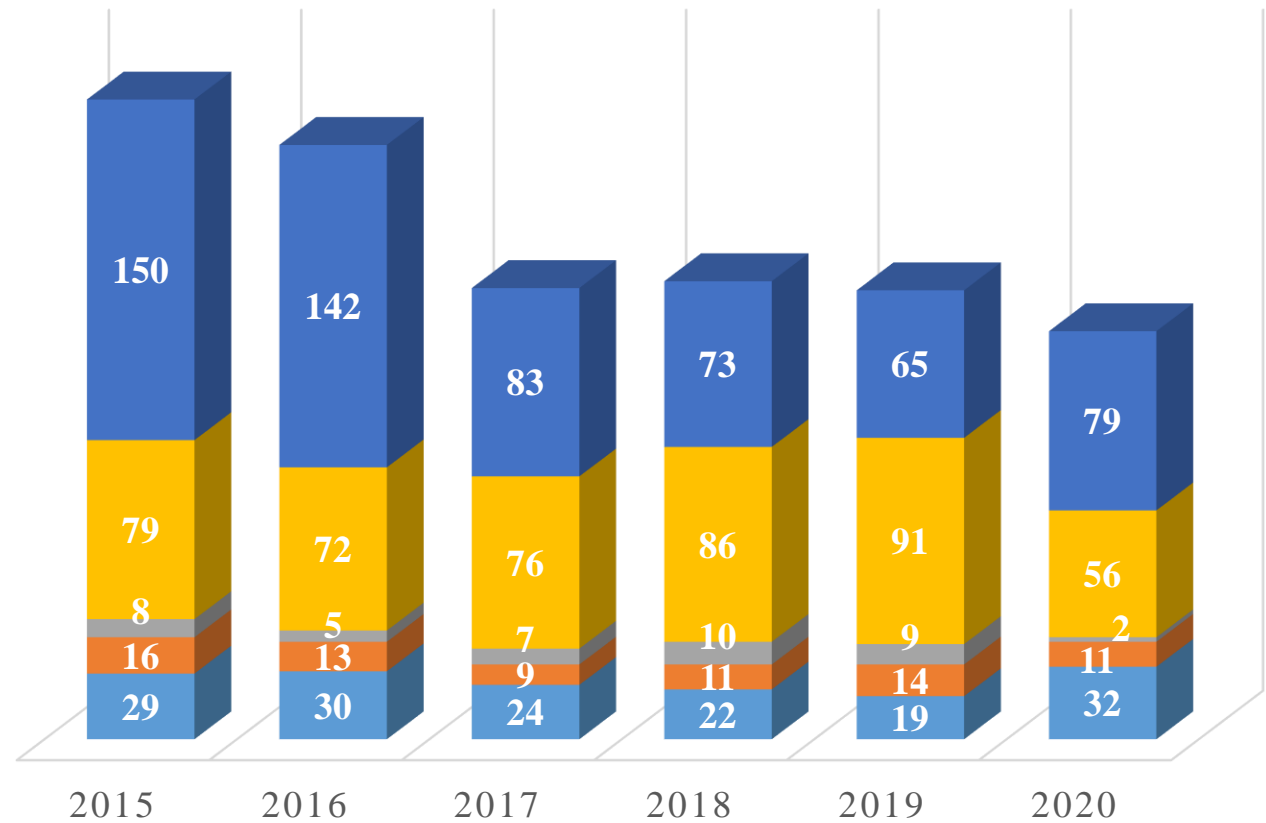


Lawrenceville Total Part II Crimes by Year

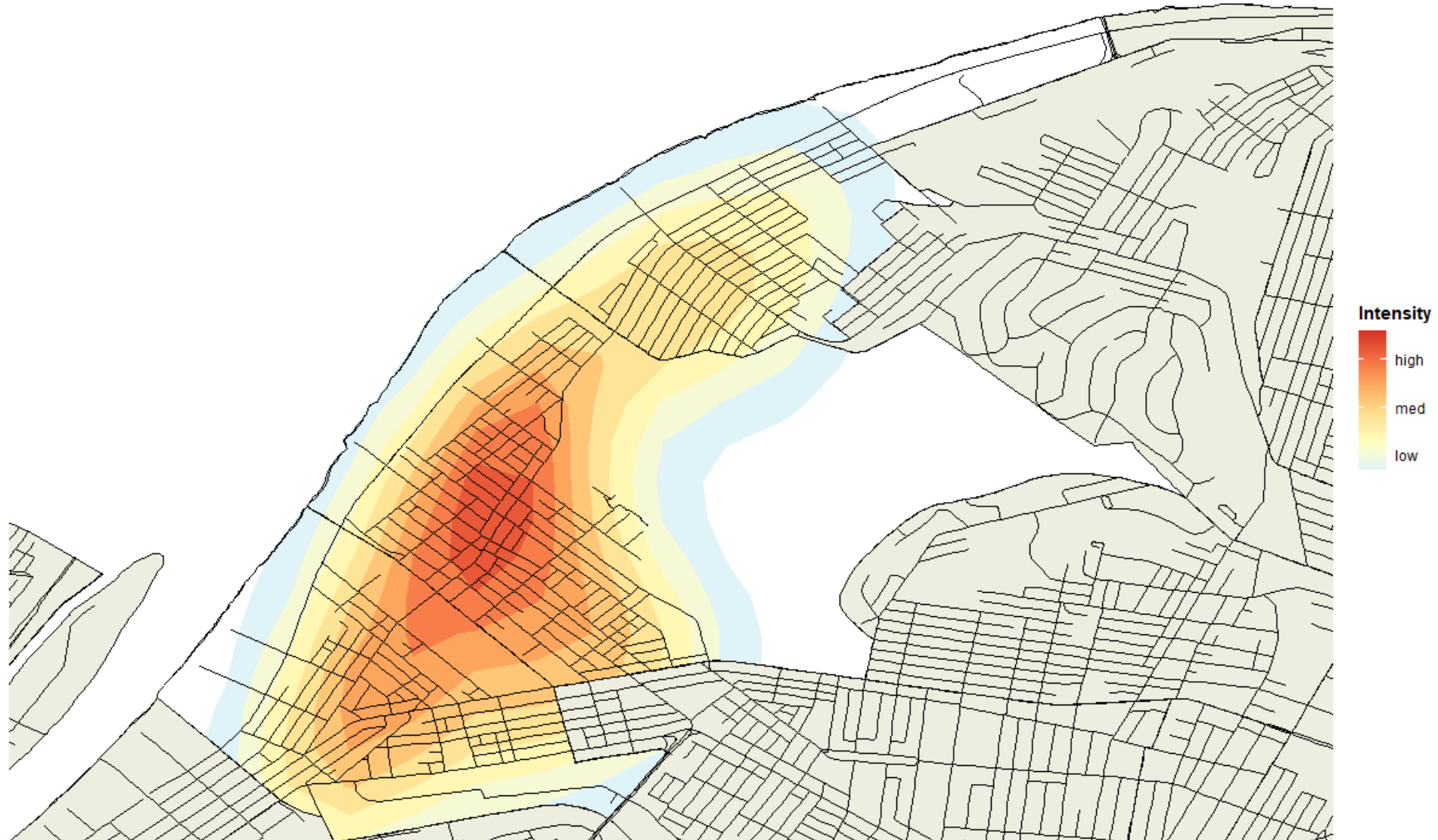

Heat Map of Part II UCR Incidents within Lawrenceville

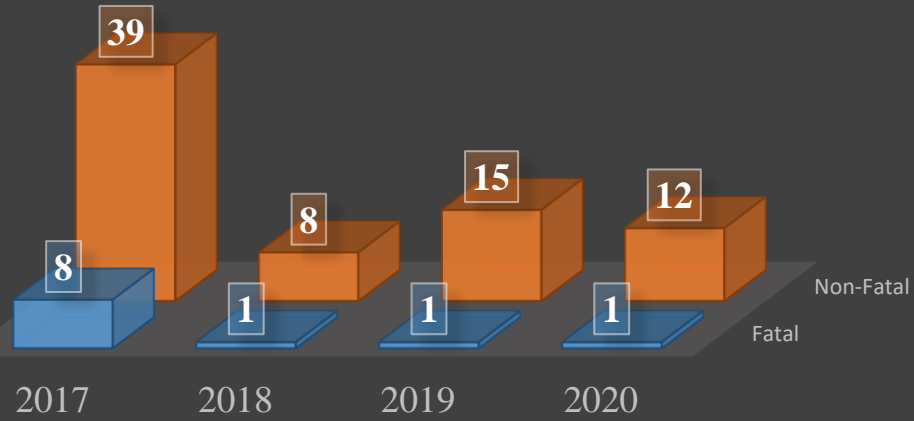

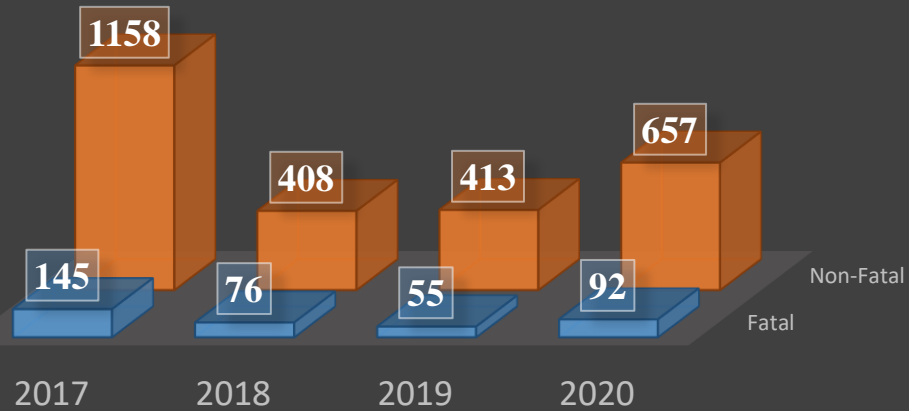
LAWRENCEVILLE OVERDOSES: 2017-2020

■ Fatal ■ Non-Fatal

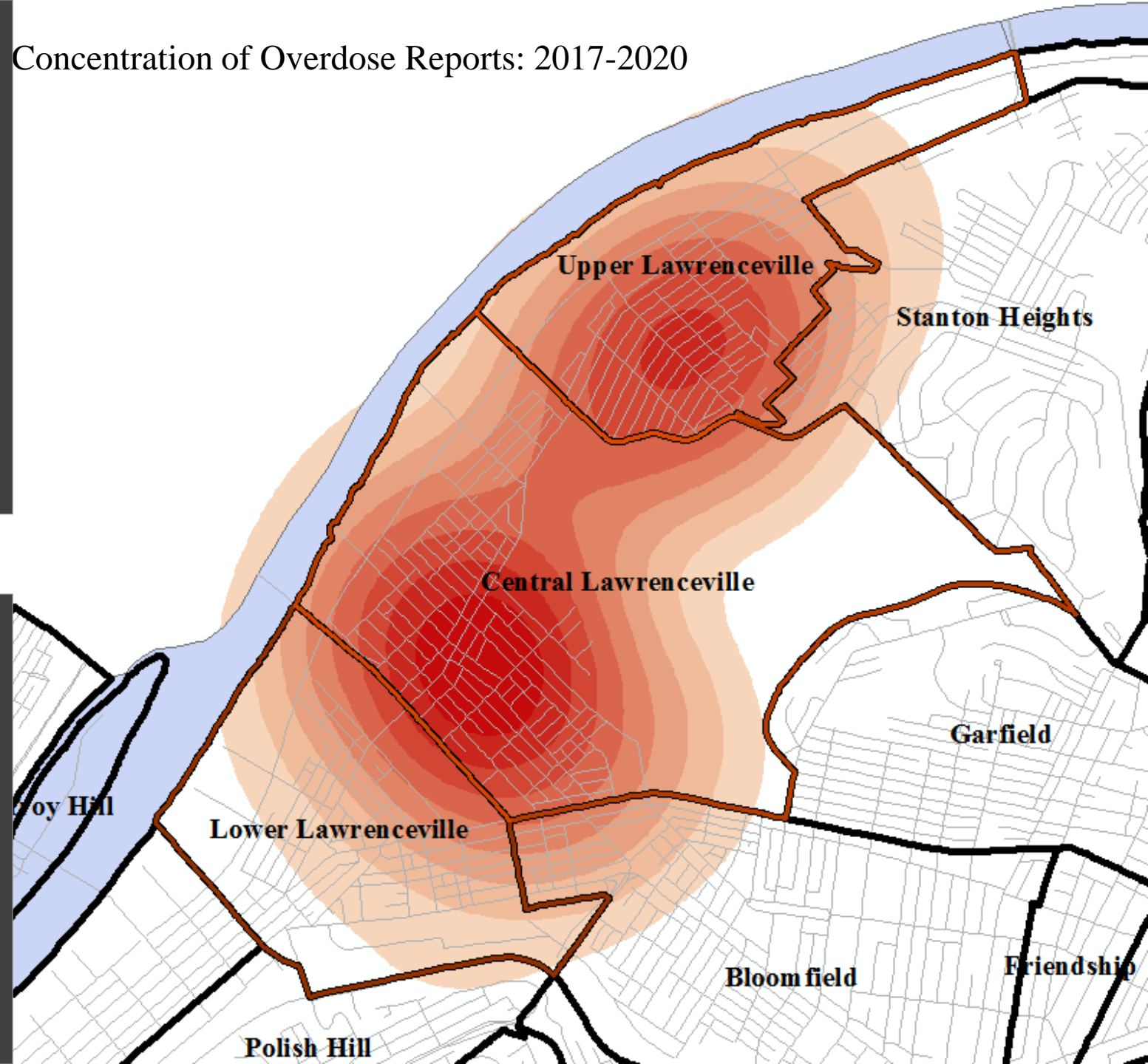


CITYWIDE OVERDOSES: 2017-2020

Takeaways...

- Crime incident counts were significantly lower in 2020 both citywide and in Lawrenceville;
- Decreases in property crimes like Burglary & Theft drove much of this trend;
- Robberies increased from last year, but are still 39% below 5 yr ave;
- Concentrations remain along Butler St. corridor (51st – 55st Streets & 40th – 45th Streets)
- Heroin Overdoses dropped significantly since highs in 2017, however have been increasing year by year since;
- Disorderly Conduct & Vandalism incidents showed increases in 2020 while Simple Assaults were down significantly;
