



### Lawrenceville Part 1 Violent Crimes by Year








### Lawrenceville Part 1 Property Crimes by Year








### Lawrenceville Total Part II Crimes by Year



Takeaways...

- ➢Crime incident counts were significantly lower in 2020 both citywide and in Lawrenceville;
- Decreases in property crimes like Burglary & Theft drove much of this trend;
- ≻Robberies increased from last year, but are still 39% below 5 yr ave;
- ➢Concentrations remain along Butler St. corridor (51<sup>st</sup> 55<sup>st</sup> Streets & 40<sup>th</sup> 45<sup>th</sup> Streets)
- Heroin Overdoses dropped significantly since highs in 2017, however have been increasing year by year since;
- Disorderly Conduct & Vandalism incidents showed increases in 2020 while Simple Assaults were down significantly;
