**Ownership Principles /Vision:** Our vision is to set a new standard for food service hospitality in Pittsburgh. We take care of each other in the building first and foremost. In creating a supportive, team-oriented, and hospitable work environment we will foster a welcoming environment for our guests, whom we will serve with a comprehensive and unwaivering commitment to hospitality.

Through a combination of our partnerships with 4 full service kitchens, a comprehensive bar with offerings from a variety of price points, and a lactose-free ice cream vendor we intend to have something for everyone.
