

Site History

- There was an above ground storage tank release in 1977-78 near Allegheny Cold Storage.
- Soil and ground water contamination.
- Remediation efforts have not worked as the sheen has reappeared
- Civil penalty imposed on previous owners for release and ground water contamination



- Part of Community Plan and Strategic Plan Program Areas
- Upgrade playground equipment
- Upgrade Basketball court
- New Benches and Seating
- Field upgrade??



Cost: ~\$450K



43rd St Overlook

- Part of the Green Boulevard Plan
- Located at the start of the Three Rivers Heritage Trail
- Provide potential access to the Allegheny River
- Benches & Lighting
- Safer barrier
- Educational materials


Cost: ~\$120K






62nd St Riverfront Access

- Kayak docks/river access , recreation uses, and riverfront access were key desires articulated in the Upper Lawrenceville Vision Plan & 62nd St site planning
- Float-in only site on Three Rivers Water Trail where people can pull up, rest, eat lunch, and enjoy the beach + fishing
- Provide public access during Tree PGH's non-operating hours by providing parking spots, man door with security camera, signage with rules and emergency info, and improved sidewalks to new steps



Cost: ~\$60K

ReLeaf Lawrenceville

- Lawrenceville = low tree canopy neighborhood at 23%, compared to City at 42%
- **Why trees?**
 - Improve air + water quality
 - Save energy
 - Calm traffic
 - Shade + cool neighborhoods
 - Reduce stormwater runoff & flooding
 - Improve people's physical & mental health
 - Provide habitat for wildlife





ReLeaf Lawrenceville

- Goal of 3:30:300 Rule
- Possible interventions
 - Expand tree canopy at community facilities that serve vulnerable pops. (e.g. CHP, Arsenal schools, senior high rises, etc.)
 - Front yards, back yards, side yards
 - Strengthen Allegheny Cemetery Arboretum program
 - MAINTENANCE
 - Street trees?
 - Industrial properties / parking lots?
 - Tree guards?
 - Education?
 - Greenway?
 - Riverfront riparian zone?
